EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA MAY -6.1987

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- The following described lands in the Alberni and Nanaimo Mining Divisions, Rupert Land District are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve.

Commencing at the point of intersection of the natural boundaries of Brooks Peninsula and Amos Creek on the right bank thereof; thence due South to the point which is 3000 m perpendicularly distant to the natural boundary on the shore of Brooks Peninsula; thence Northwesterly, Northerly, and Northeasterly parallel to, and 3000 m perpendicularly distant from the natural boundary of Brooks Peninsula, to the intersection with the Westerly prolongation of the Southerly boundary of S.T.L. 5198P; thence Easterly along the said Westerly prolongation of the Southerly boundary of S.T.L. 5198P to the Southwest corner of said S.T.L. 5198P; thence Easterly along the said Southerly boundary of S.T.L. 5198P to the natural boundary of Harris Creek on the left bank thereof; thence Southwesterly in a straight line to the most Southerly Southeast corner of S.T.L. 1875P; thence due South to the point of intersection with the Westerly prolongation of the Southerly boundary of S.T.L. 9586P; thence due East to the Southerly boundary of the Klaskish Inlet watershed; thence in a Southeasterly direction along the Southwesterly boundary of the Klaskish Inlet watershed to the point of intersection with the Westerly boundary of the watershed of Johnson Lagoon; thence



Southeasterly in a straight line to a point on the natural boundary of Brooks Peninsula and Nasparti Inlet, said point being due South of the Southeast corner of S.T.L. 5199P; thence in a straight line at a bearing of 160° to the natural boundary of Nasparti Inlet, on the Easterly shore thereof; thence due West to the natural boundary of Nasparti Inlet, on the Westerly shore thereof; thence Southwesterly and Westerly along the natural boundary of Brooks Peninsula to the point of intersection of the natural boundaries of Brooks Peninsula and Amos Creek, on the right bank thereof, said point being the point of commencement.

2. The lands described are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve until August 31, 1988.
3. No free miner shall stake or acquire a location or record or locate a mineral claim in the reserve created by Section 1.
