EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA JUL. 15.1987

On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- The following described lands in the Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve:

Site 1

Lot 9973

Site 2

Lots 3474 and 6823.

Site 3

Commencing at a point 6 700 metres east and 3 600 metres north of the northeast corner of Lot 9619; thence due north a distance of 700 metres; thence due east a distance of 800 metres; thence due south a distance of 700 metres; thence in a westerly direction in a straight line a distance of 800 metres, more or less, to a point 6 700 metres east and 3 600 metres north of the northeast corner of Lot 9619, being the point of commencement.

Site 4
