On the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

- The following described lands in the Liard Mining Division, Cassiar Land District are established as a mineral reserve and as a placer mining reserve:

Commencing at the summit of Mount Talbot, being on the Alaska-British Columbia border; thence northerly in a straight line a distance of 15.6 km, more or less, to the summit of Hole in the Wall Mountain; thence north-westerly in a straight line a distance of 22.2 km, more or less, to the summit of Dominion Mountain; thence northeasterly in a straight line a distance of 38.4 km, more or less, to the summit of Mount Donaker; thence northeasterly in a straight line a distance of 36.6 km, more or less, to the summit of Isolation Mountain; thence northeasterly in a straight line a distance of 21.0 km, more or less, to the summit of Mount Glenora; thence North 41° East a distance of 60 km; thence southeasterly in a straight line to the summit of Mount St. Mary; thence North 78° East a distance of 43.8 km; thence South 01° 30' East a distance of 30 km; thence south-westerly in a straight line to the summit of Cartmel Mountain; thence northwesterly in a straight line a distance of 33 km, more or less, to the summit of Thatue Mountain; thence northwesterly in a straight line a distance of 50.4 km, more or less, to the summit of Mount Meehaus; thence southwesterly in a straight line a distance of 49.8 km, more or less, to the summit of Mount Gordon; thence southwesterly in a straight line a distance of 19.2 km, more or less, to the summit of Mount Helveker; thence southwesterly in a straight line a distance of 7.8 km, more or less, to the summit of Strata Mountain; thence southwesterly in a straight line a distance of 49.2 km, more or less, to the summit of Saddle Mountain; thence southwesterly in a straight line a distance of 33.6 km, more or less, to the summit of The


