



## SCHEDULE A

AREA 4 - SITE 3 -- Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District, Cariboo Electoral District

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water, more particularly described as the watershed of Mitchell River west of the 120°30' meridian of west longitude.

AREA 4 - SITE 5 -- Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District, Cariboo Electoral District

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water more particularly as shown outlined in black on the attached map.

AREA 4 - SITE 6.5 -- Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District, Cariboo Electoral District

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water and more particularly as shown outlined in black on the attached map.

AREA 4 - SITE 7 -- Omineca Mining Division, Range 5 Coast Land District, Omineca Electoral District

An area 1000 m wide, being 500 m on each side of the middle line of Stellako River from its confluence with Fraser Lake westerly to its confluence with Francois Lake.

AREA 4 - SITE 8 -- Cariboo and Omineca Mining Divisions, Cariboo, Range 5 Coast and Cassiar Land Districts, Omineca and Prince George North Electoral Districts

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water, more particularly as shown outlined in black on the attached map, save and except Dog Creek Designated Placer Area as described in B. C. Regulation 509/82, Tsah Creek Designated Placer Area as described in B. C. Regulation 440/80, Sowchea Creek Designated Placer Area as described in B. C. Regulation 413/75, and Manson Creek Designated Placer Area as described in B. C. Regulation 413/75.

AREA 4 - SITE 9 -- Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District, Prince George South Electoral District

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water and more particularly described as the watersheds of Seebach Creek and East Seebach Creek west of the 122° meridian of west longitude.

AREA 4 - SITE 10 -- Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District, Prince George South Electoral District

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water, more particularly as shown outlined in black on the attached map.

AREA 4 - SITE 11 -- Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District, Prince George South Electoral District

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water more particularly as shown outlined in black on the attached map.

AREA 4 - SITE 12 -- Omineca Mining Division, Range 4 Coast Land District, Omineca Electoral District

An area 1000 m wide being 500 m on each side of the middle line of Corkscrew Creek from its confluence with Nulki Lake to the southerly boundary of Section 17, Township 6.

AREA 4 - SITE 13 -- Cariboo Mining Division, Cariboo Land District, Cariboo and Prince George South Electoral Districts

Commencing at the point of intersection of the centre line of the right of way for Highway 16 with a line, said line being parallel to and 500 m perpendicularly distant from the present natural boundary of Bowron River on the right bank thereof; thence in a general southeasterly direction along a line, said line being parallel to and 500 m perpendicularly distant from the present natural boundary of Bowron River on the right bank thereof to its point of intersection with the present natural boundary of Bowron Lake; thence in a general southwesterly direction along the present natural boundary of Bowron Lake to its point of intersection with a line, said line being parallel to and 500 m perpendicularly distant from the present natural boundary of Bowron River on the left bank thereof; thence in a general northwesterly direction along a line, said line being parallel to and 500 m perpendicularly distant from the present natural boundary of Bowron River on the left bank thereof to its point of intersection with the centre line of the right of way for Highway 16; thence in a general southeasterly direction along said centre line to its point of intersection with a line, said line being parallel to and 500 m perpendicularly distant from the present natural boundary of Bowron River on the right bank thereof, said point being the point of commencement.
