REGULATION OF THE MINISTER


IN THE MATTER OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT
S.B.C. 1988, C. 5

1. By the authority vested in me under the provisions of section 18 of the *Mineral Tenure Act*, I hereby establish a reserve for minerals and placer minerals over the following described lands in the Kootenay Land District, Nelson and Trail Creek Mining Divisions and Rossland-Trail Electoral District, effective May 30, 1989:

An area 1500 m wide, being 750 m on each side of the centre line of the right of way of the proposed Keenleyside-Selkirk Transmission Line as shown on the accompanying sketch.

2. No free miner shall obstruct, endanger or interfere with or allow any other person to obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of a transmission line in the reserve created by section 1.
