


REGULATION OF THE MINISTER

IN THE MATTER OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT  
S.B.C. 1988, c.5

1. By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Section 18 of the Mineral Tenure Act, I hereby rescind B. C. Reg. 460/81 and establish a mineral and placer mineral reserve over the following land in the Revelstoke Mining Division, Kootenay Land District:

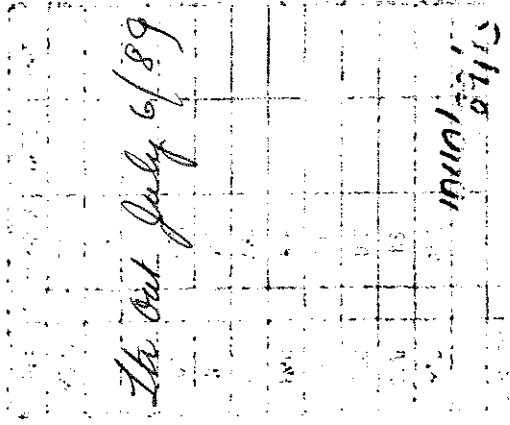
Commencing at the point of intersection of the northerly boundary of Section 9, Township 24, Range 2, West of the Sixth Meridian, with the natural boundary of Columbia River on the right bank thereof; thence westerly, along the northerly boundary of said Section 9, a distance of 500 m; thence due south to the southerly boundary of the aforementioned Section 9; thence easterly along the southerly boundary and its easterly prolongation to the point of intersection with the Revelstoke City municipal boundary as shown on attached sketch; thence northerly along the said municipal boundary to the point of intersection with the easterly prolongation of the northerly boundary of the aforementioned Section 9; thence westerly along the said northerly boundary and its easterly prolongation to the point of intersection with the natural boundary of Columbia River on the right bank thereof, being the point of commencement.

2. No free miner shall locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve created by Section 1.
