

REGULATION OF THE MINISTER  
IN THE MATTER OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT  
S.B.C. 1988, C.5

M 181

1. By the authority vested in me under the provisions of section 18 of the Mineral Tenure Act, I hereby establish a reserve for minerals over the following described land in the Vancouver Mining Division, New Westminster Land District until August 1, 1995:

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water situated within the New Westminster Group 1 Land District, more particularly described as an area 1600 metres wide, being 800 metres on either side of a straight line drawn from the northwest corner of Lot 985 at a bearing of 321° for a distance of 5000 metres.

2. A free miner may locate or record a mineral claim on all or part of the land in the mineral reserve subject to the conditions in section 3.

3. No free miner shall obstruct, endanger or interfere with or allow any other person to obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of a hydroelectric project in the reserve created by section 1.
