

REGULATION OF THE MINISTER

IN THE MATTER OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT  
S.B.C. 1988, C.5

1. By the authority vested in me under the provisions of section 18 of the Mineral Tenure Act, I hereby establish a mineral reserve over the following described land in the Skeena Mining Division, Coast, Range 4 and Coast, Range 5 Land Districts:

Commencing at the intersection of the 500 foot contour of elevation and the westerly boundary of Lot 121, Coast, Range 4 Land District;

Thence following the 500 foot contour in a generally westerly, southerly, northerly and easterly direction around Brown Lake to its intersection with the southerly boundary of said Lot 121;

Thence easterly, northerly, northwesterly and southerly along the southerly, easterly, northerly and westerly boundaries of said Lot 121 to the intersection of the 500 foot contour of elevation with the westerly boundary of Lot 121, being the point of commencement.

2. A free miner may locate or record a mineral claim on all or part of the land in the mineral reserve subject to the conditions in section 3.

3. No free miner shall obstruct, endanger or interfere with or allow any other person to obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of a hydro project in the reserve created by section 1.
