REGULATION OF THE MINISTER
IN THE MATTER OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT
S.B.C. 1988, C.5

1. By the authority vested in me under the provisions of section 18 of the Mineral Tenure Act, I hereby rescind Regulation of the Minister M249/91 (B.C. Regulation 294/91) and establish a reserve for minerals and placer minerals over the following described lands in the Nanaimo and Victoria Mining Divisions, and the Alberni, Bright, Cameron, Chemainus, Cowichan Lake, Cranberry, Mountain, Nanoose, Nanaimo, Newcastle, Seymour, Somenos and Wellington Land Districts:

An area, 20 metres wide, being 10 metres on each side of the centerline of the proposed right-of-way of the British Columbia Telephone Company Lightguide Transmission Line, as shown on the attached sketch.

2. No free miner shall locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve created by section 1.

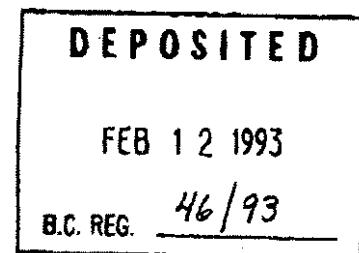
