**REGULATION OF THE MINISTER**

**IN THE MATTER OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT  
S.B.C. 1988, C.5**

1. By the authority vested in me under the provisions of section 18 of the Mineral Tenure Act, I hereby establish a reserve for minerals and placer minerals over the following described land in the Nanaimo Mining Division, Wellington and Mountain Land Districts:

An area, one kilometre wide, being 500 metres on each side of the centerline of the proposed Nanaimo Parkway as shown on the attached sketch.

2. A free miner may locate or record a mineral or placer claim on all or part of the land in the mineral and placer mineral reserve subject to the conditions in section 3.

3. No free miner shall obstruct, endanger or interfere with or allow any other person to obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of the proposed Nanaimo Parkway in the reserve created by section 1.
