

REGULATION OF THE MINISTER
IN THE MATTER OF THE MINERAL TENURE ACT
S.B.C. 1988, C.5

1. By the authority vested in me under the provisions of section 18 of the Mineral Tenure Act, I hereby establish a reserve for minerals and placer minerals over the following described land in the Nanaimo Mining Division, Cranberry, Douglas, Mountain, Wellington, Nanoose and Dunsmuir Land Districts until February 1, 2000:

An area 1000 metres wide, being 500 metres on either side of the centerline of the proposed Nanaimo Outer Route, as shown outlined on the attached sketch.

2. A free miner may locate or record a mineral or placer claim on all or part of the land in the mineral and placer mineral reserve subject to the conditions in section 3.

3. No free miner shall obstruct, endanger or interfere with or allow any other person to obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of the proposed Nanaimo Outer Route in the reserve created by section 1.
