I, Dan Miller, Minister of Energy and Mines, order that

1. The reserves created by Order in Council 1880/70; Order in Council 1184/73, (B.C. Regulation 76/73); Order in Council 1419/73, (B.C. Regulation 108/73); Order in Council 2309/73, (B.C. Regulation 217/73); Order in Council 927/75, (B.C. Regulation 235/75); Order in Council 2371/77, (B.C. Regulation 292/77); Order in Council 1511/87, (B.C. Regulation 264/87); Order in Council 901/87, (B.C. Regulation 138/87); Order in Council 127/88, (B.C. Regulation 29/88); Order in Council 903/87 (B.C. Regulation 140/87); Regulation of the Minister M148/90, (B.C. Regulation 213/90) all be rescinded.

2. Regulation of the Minister M149/90, (B.C. Regulation 214/90), be amended by deleting:

**DRINKWATER CREEK AREA**

All that parcel or tract of land, together with all that foreshore or land covered by water, as shown outlined on the attached sketch.

and by repealing the accompanying sketch.


3. A reserve be established for minerals and placer minerals over the lands listed in Schedule A in the Nanaimo Mining Division, Comox Land District:

All those parcels or tracts of land together with all that foreshore or lands covered by water as shown outlined and shaded on the attached sketches.

4. A free miner must not locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve created by section 3.

## BUTTLE LAKE

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that land covered by water, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of Block 126, being a point on the westerly boundary of the Esquimalt and Nanaimo Railway Land Grant, thence northerly along the easterly boundary of said Block 126 to the southerly boundary of Block 1012, thence easterly, northerly, westerly, southerly, easterly, southerly, easterly, southerly, easterly, southerly and westerly along the southerly, easterly, northerly, and westerly boundaries of said Block 1012 to the natural boundary of Buttle Lake on the easterly shore thereof, thence northerly along the said natural boundary of Buttle Lake and the natural boundary of Upper Campbell Lake on the easterly shore thereof to the northerly boundary of that part of Block 121 lying to the east of said Buttle and Upper Campbell Lakes, thence easterly 82 chains more or less along said boundary and beyond to the easterly boundary of the watershed of said Upper Campbell Lake, thence in a general southeasterly direction along the said boundary and the easterly boundary of the watershed of said Buttle Lake to the aforesaid westerly boundary of the Esquimalt and Nanaimo Railway Land Grant, thence northwesterly along said boundary to the aforesaid southeast corner of Block 126, being the point of commencement.
