

Mineral Tenure Act

I, Dan Miller, Minister of Energy and Mines, order that

1. A reserve be established for minerals and placer minerals over the following land in the Fort Steele Mining Division, Kootenay I. and District:

2. A free miner must not locate or record a mineral or placer claim in the reserve created by section 1.
