Mineral Tenure Act

I, Gerald German, Chief Gold Commissioner, Ministry of Energy and Mines, order that


- 1. B.C. Reg. 200/79 and B.C. Reg. 59/69 are rescinded, and
- 2. A mineral reserve is established over the following lands in the Omineca Mining Division, Range 5, Coast Land District:

All that parcel or tract of land together with all that foreshore or land covered by water as shown outlined and shaded on the attached sketch.

- 3. A free miner may locate or record a mineral claim in the reserve established by section 2 subject to the conditions listed in section 4.
- 4. A free miner must not obstruct, endanger or interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of a ski resort in the reserve established by section 2.
