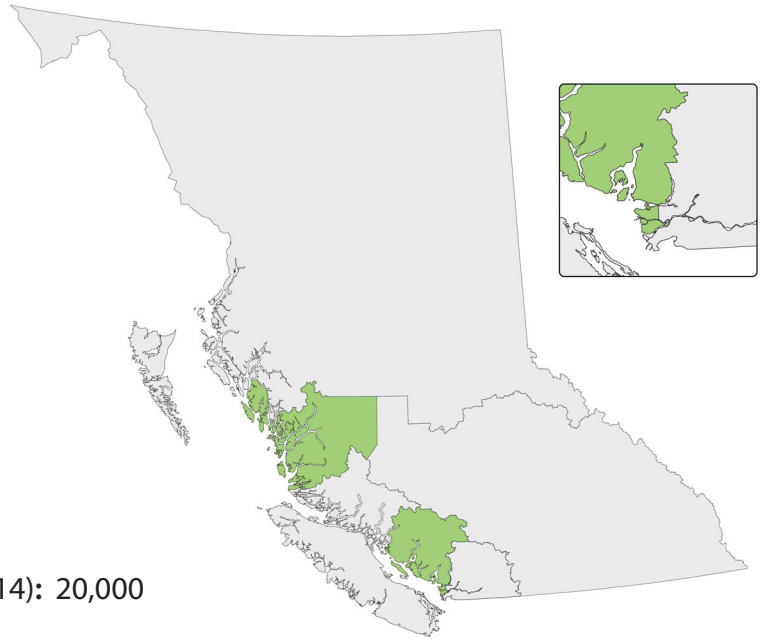

Major Capital Investments

- Vancouver General Hospital expansions, including:
 - ▶ \$123 million for **Diamond Centre** (academic ambulatory care), and
 - ▶ \$156 million redevelopment of **Vancouver General Hospital**.
- \$99 million for renovations and upgrades to **St. Paul's Hospital**.
- \$62 million for the **HOpe Centre**, an acute mental health facility at Lions Gate Hospital.
- \$82 million for the **Joseph & Rosalie Segal Family Health Centre** at Vancouver General Hospital.
- \$44 million to renovate **Sechelt Hospital**.
