



CANCELLATION OF ASSIGNMENT OF MSP PAYMENTS FOR DIAGNOSTIC FACILITY SERVICES

Preamble to the Payment Schedule - 3. Assignment of Payment

An "Assignment of Payment" is a legal agreement by which an attending physician designates payment for his/her services to another party. In this circumstance, the designated party may use the attending physician's practitioner number in combination with its own payment number when submitting claims to MSP. To authorize MSP to make payment to a designated party, the attending physician must complete and file an "Assignment of Payment" form. However, even though the payment has been assigned, the responsibility for the clinical service and its appropriate billing remains with the physician whose practitioner number is used.

Physicians who have made a two (2) year assignment of payment to a diagnostic facility must advise MSP in writing if he or she ceases to be associated with the diagnostic facility before the assignment expires.
