00272	Consultation to include a history and physical examination, review of x-rays, laboratory findings , manipulation and a written report to the referring physician (Patient aged 0 – 69)	\$95.17	\$96.48
00273	Non-referred initial visit including manipulation (Patient aged 70 plus)	\$52.33	\$53.05
00274	Subsequent visit including manipulation (Patient aged 70 plus)	\$42.94	\$43.53
00275	Consultation to include a history and physical examination, review of x-rays, laboratory findings , manipulation and a written report to the referring physician (Patient aged 70 plus)	\$114.27	\$115.84
00276	Prolonged visit and/or counselling for complex case to include a history and physical examination, review of X-ray findings and laboratory findings and manipulation (Patient aged 0 – 69)	\$59.79	\$60.61
00277	Prolonged visit and/or counselling for complex case to include a history and physical examination, review of X-ray findings and laboratory findings and manipulation (Patient aged 70 plus)	\$74.75	\$75.78
00279	Osteopathic Complex Care Management Fee. This recognizes the extra time required beyond the office visit for a complex case which may include review of prior records, specialist’s reports, lab results, imaging studies, discussion with other health professionals, and the development of a treatment/ care plan.
