Objectives:

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) Youth Toolkit includes a user guide, an electronic presentation for youth, a human trafficking awareness video (sexual exploitation), youth posters, *I’m Not for Sale* youth booklet, parent help sheet, Human Trafficking National Coordination Centre (HTNCC) pamphlet, frequently asked questions and answers, and handouts.

The RCMP developed this public resource to educate and spread awareness about the issue of human trafficking, with particular emphasis on sexual exploitation of youth. It is part of the public awareness campaign called *I’m Not for Sale* launched by the HTNCC that is targeted towards the general public, including potential or existing victims.

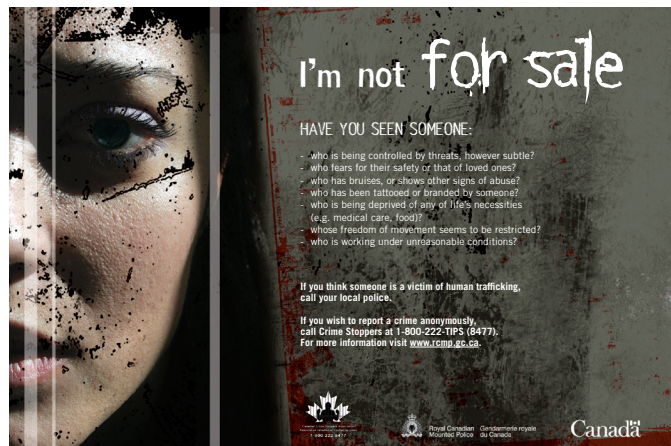
Organization:
