## **WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 1 to 7 Dec 2014**

### **BODY RECOVERY**

On 07 Dec 14, Cowichan Valley SAR were requested by RCMP to assist with a body recovery in the Osborne Bay Road area of North Cowichan on 08 Dec 2014.

### **FLOOD**

On 02 Dec 14, the Township of Golden activated their EOC to address impacts due to an ice jam on the Kicking Horse River. MOTI, FLNRO and local government coordinated to mitigate flooding damage to residential properties and infrastructure.

On 02 Dec 14, EMBC SEA activated their PREOC to support local government and Provincial Ministries mitigate damage caused by an ice jam in the Kicking Horse River potentially impacting the township of Golden and Provincial assets.

On 04 Dec 14, the East Kootenay Regional District activated an EOC in response to flooding caused by an ice jam on the Elk River.

On 05 Dec 14, the District of Sicamous EOC was activated to address flooding, caused by an ice jam, of a low lying residential area, a low lying industrial area and two bridges. Both MOTI and FLNRO were engaged in mitigation.

On 07 Dec 14, the City of North Vancouver activated their EOC to address damage to residential properties and infrastructure caused by a land slide into Seymour river.

### **MISCELLANEOUS**

On 01 Dec 14, The City of Surrey were advised of a trailer park potentially displacing residents from 10 to 12 units of a trailer park because of a power outage.

On 02 Dec 14, EMBC PECC activated at level 1 to support Federal and Provincial Ministries deal with an outbreak of Avian Influenza in the lower mainland.

On 03 Dec 14, the City of Kamloops opened a warming centre for the residents of a residential neighborhood that had been tactically evacuated by police.

On 07 Dec 14, tasking for Keremeos Fire as requested by BCAS to provide rope rescue assistance for a subject down a ravine off Chopka Road in the Cawston area.
