BODY RECOVERY

On 16 Feb 14, Abbotsford Police requested assistance from Central Fraser Valley SAR after a body was located near the Matsqui Dike.

POWER OUTAGE

On 12 Feb 14, the EOC was activated and ESS was engaged to assist in arranging community warming centres in four Nisga'a Lisims communities due to an extended power outage.

On 14 Feb 14, a warming centre was opened up for residents of Stewart due to a prolonged power outage in the community.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 14 Feb 14, Revelstoke ESS responded to assist residence who were evacuated from their home due to a a buildup of carbon monoxide. The building was vented, but as no source of the CO2 was identified the occupants chose to stay with friends overnight.

On 16 Feb 14, Surrey ESS arranged for overnight accommodations and meals for a family of 4 that had been displaced from their home after a tree went through the roof causing significant structural damage. The Fire Department determined that the residence was not safe to occupy and the power was cut until the damaged roof could be repaired.
