On 22 Apr 15, a task was issued to the Bulkley Valley Regional District for possible flooding due to a high stream advisory for the Nautley River near Fort Fraser and the Nechako River at Vanderhoof.

On 22 Apr 15, a task was issued for the District of Vanderhoof to deal with flood related activities.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 21 Apr 15, a family of three was displaced from their residence in Tappen due to an ingress of stove oil through the foundation, possibly due to a leaking underground storage tank.

On 24 Apr 15, Lumby Fire responded to a male trapped under a fallen tree. The male was found to be deceased and upon arrival of the Coroner, Fire Department personnel recovered his body.
