On 10 Dec 15, the missing subject from SAR 151131 was located deceased on Boulder Mountain by others. 11 Revelstoke SAR responded to assist the RCMP and Coroner Service to recover the body.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 11 Dec 15, a rainbow sheen was reported on the Fraser River near McDonald Beach Park in Vancouver. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) for notification purposes. The incident was immediately downgraded.
