BODY RECOVERY

On 17 Feb 15, North Shore Rescue responded to assist the Coroner in recovering a body in Hanes Valley. The deceased individual was recovered and turned over to the Coroner.

LANDSLIDES

On 16 Feb 15, a task was issued to Enderby ESS following a landslide along Highway 97A, approximately 15 km south of Sicamous, that caused significant damage to a single family home with two occupants.

On 17 Feb 15, the City of Salmon Arm activated an EOC at level 1 to provide site support for a landslide that damaged Foothills Road, exposing gas and water lines.

On 18 Feb 15, a home and garage were destroyed by a landslide on Sunnybrae Road in Columbia Shuswap Regional District.
