**WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 02 to 08 February 2015**

**DANGEROUS GOODS**

On 08 Feb 2015, in Kitimat at the MK Bay Marina approximately 6 pleasure vessels sunk due to heavy snowfall. At the Federal Haisla Nation Marina, 3 vessels and dock fingers sunk. The sunken vessels have caused a fuel sheen and a noticeable amount of oil in the area. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the level of the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status). Coast Guard will be conducting an overflight of the area to assess potential environmental impacts and effected vessels. Coast Guard has a container of spill response equipment staged at the MK Bay facility.

**FLOODING/LANDSLIDES**

On 06 Feb 2015, a task was issued to the Village of Pemberton who activated their EOC in response to localized flooding caused by heavy rains, affecting infrastructure and impacting their water treatment plant.

On 06 Feb 15 a task was issued to the Central Kootenay Regional District (CKRD) in response to a road washout on Highway 6 near Balfour, a mudslide in Nelson that may impact Highway 3A and a landslide in the Pass Creek Road area.

On 07 Feb 15 the Squamish Lillooet Regional District activated their EOC in response to overland flooding that was threatening homes in the area.

On 08 Feb 15 a task was issued to the Columbia Shuswap Regional District (CSRD) following a landslide impacting one summer residence on Lichen Road in Anglemont.

**WINTER STORM**

On 06 Feb, 2015 the District of Kitimat opened their EOC in response to a winter storm event that brought heavy snowfall to the area resulting in mobility issues and a widespread power outage affecting 7,000 residents. The SAR snowmobile team was deployed to make positive contact and offer support if required.

On 07 Feb, 2015 an AANDC task number was opened for the Kitimat Village First Nations, assisted by the District of Kitimat, to address impacts resulting from a winter storm event.
