WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT January 19 to 25, 2015

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 24 Jan 15, there was an ammonia leak at the Recreation Centre in McBride resulting in an evacuation of approximately 40 homes that were within a 1 km radius of the building. An additional 40 homes and the hospital followed a shelter in place protocol. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the level of the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) until the leak was repaired and the area deemed safe for residents to return.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 22 Jan 15, Quesnel and Prince George Search and Rescue members responded to assist RCMP with an evidence search in the Quesnel area.

FLOOD

On 18 Jan 15, a task number was generated for the Cowichan Valley Regional District in order to monitor potential impacts of a log jam that formed on the Koksilah River following heavy rains.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 24 Jan 15, a task was issued for a reception centre that was opened in McBride to accommodate the residents of 40 homes that were evacuated due to an ammonia leak. Robson Valley SAR volunteers assisted RCMP and Fire Rescue with the door to door evacuation.
