BODY RECOVERY

On 25 May 15, Terrace SAR conducted body recovery in the Kalum Lake area at the request of the RCMP.

On 31 May 15, Kamloops SAR conducted a body recovery in the Lytton area. The team was stood down with no results.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 25 May 15, a six inch diameter natural gas pipeline was punctured in the City of Vancouver. Homes in the immediate vicinity were evacuated and one elementary school was advised to "shelter in place" while Fortis isolated the gas line and repairs were done to prevent any further release. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status). The City of Vancouver activated their EOC to address both situational awareness and public messaging.
