WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 30 Nov – 06 Dec 2015

DANGEROUS GOOD

On 30 Nov 15, an oil spill was reported in the Gorge Waterway between Esquimalt and Saanich. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 01 Dec 15, a fuel slick occurred on the south side of Burrard Inlet. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 02 Dec 15, waste from a clandestine drug lab was dumped on the FSR off the end of Burma Road, 3 to 4 kilometers from the Stave Lake Dam near Mission. Both sides of Rolly Creek were impacted by the material. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) and attended the scene with the Conservation Officer, the RCMP and hazardous waste company.

FLOODING

On 01 Dec 15, Golden activated their EOC at level 1 to monitor potential flooding from an ice jam in the Kicking Horse River.

On 03 Dec. 2015, the Strathcona Regional District activated an EOC in response to local flooding.

On 03 Dec. 2015, the City of Courtenay activated an EOC in response to local flooding of the Courtenay River.

On 05 Dec 2015, Tseshaht First Nations activated their EOC to prepare for flooding of the Somass River in the Port Alberni area.

POWER OUTAGE

On 03 Dec 15, the City of Port Coquitlam required a task for several residents due to a power outage and potential live wires. Coast Mountain Bus was contacted to provide shelter for approximately 10 people.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 06 Dec 15, Emergency Social Services assistance was provided for one person when their live-aboard boat sank in Cowichan Bay.
