WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Nov 09 – 15 2015

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 10 Nov 2015, a long slick was reported at the south end of the Burrard Street Bridge, along the seawall. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to the potential for heightened media attention. No recoverable oil was located.

On 12 Nov 2015, during a storm event 3 pleasure craft were blown up onto the beach at Gyro Park in Saanich. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 13 Nov 15, a report was received about a pond at the South Island Aggregates yard that breached, spilling unknown contaminants into Shawnigan Lake. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status) by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO). Upon investigation it was found to be a non-event.

SEVERE STORM

On 12 Nov 2015, an EOC was opened in Vancouver to handle issues from the storm approaching the city.

FLOODING

On 13 Nov 2015, a task number was created for the Capital Regional District to track the multiple flooding incidents in the Sooke area.
