WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 28 SEP – 04 OCT 2015

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 28 Sep 15, Coast Guard Environmental Response responded to a tug boat that sank in the middle of the Strait of Georgia while transiting from Chemainus to the Shelter Island Marina in Richmond. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential pollution and heightened media attention.

On 29 Sep 15, there was a sheen reported in the Sechelt Inlet on the south side of Porpoise Bay. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential pollution and heightened media attention.

On 30 Sep 15, Coast Guard Environmental Response responded to a 25 foot pleasure craft that sank 150 nautical miles west of the North Arm Jetty by Point Grey in Vancouver. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential pollution and heightened media attention.

On 1 Oct 15, A citizen passing over the Cambie Street Bridge, in Vancouver reported a slick on False Creek. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential pollution and heightened media attention.

On 1 Oct 15, A citizen spotted a small overturned boat with a small slick around it, just off shore of Beach Ave and Jervis in the West End of Vancouver. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the pollution and potential for heightened media attention.

On 02 Oct 15, an unrecoverable sheen was reported on the water in False Creek near Quayside Marina, Vancouver. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised an incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential for heightened media attention.

On 02 Oct 15, an oil spill was reported by the boat launch at Gibson's Marina The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised an incident to Code 2 (urgent status). The oil slick was found to be from oil on the road surface that had washed into a local creek when it rained.
