WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 25 - 31 Jan 16

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 26 Jan 16, a sewage and high fecal coliform count was reported in Pepin Brooke that flows through Aldergrove Regional Park through to the US border. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) for notification purposes on the trans-border issue. The incident was immediately downgraded.

On 28 Jan 16, a rock slide occurred on Highway 1 west of Hope causing multiple vehicle incidents that resulted in diesel and vehicle fluids to leak to the road surface in close proximity to the Fraser River during heavy rains. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) while highways crews responded.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 29 Jan 16, Campbell River ESS responded to assist RCMP with residential evacuations due to a police incident.

ENVIRONMENTAL

On 28 Jan 16, the Comox Valley Regional District opened an EOC in response to possible flooding.

On 28 Jan 16, an ESS task number was provided to a family of 3 who were displaced by flooding in the Fraser Valley Regional District.
