WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 25 – 31 JUL 2016

BODY RECOVERY

On 29 Jul 17 Terrace SAR responded to assist RCMP and BCAS with a body recovery at Delta Creek on Hwy 16.

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 25 Jul 16, the media reported sanitary sewage noticed at a storm water outflow going into Elk River. A Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) responded to the location and raised the incident to a Code 2 (Urgent Status) for dissemination purposes. Following consultation between MOE and the City of Fernie it was determined the spill was from an improperly installed service to a single address with intermittent flows. City crews investigated the source to make proper repairs to a single address with intermittent flows.

URBAN INTERFACE FIRE

On 30 Jul 16, Vernon activated their EOC to Level 1 to assist with the evacuation of a neighborhood on Tronson Road due to an interface fire.

FLOODING

On 30 Jul 16, Squamish Lillooet Regional District activated their EOC in response to flooding from creeks near Seton Portage, following a heavy rainfall event.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 25 Jul 16, Squamish SAR responded to a report of a dog going over a waterfall. They spoke to the owners and advised on the dangers of trying a rescue on their own and owners agreed.

On 25 Jul 16, Princeton Hwy Rescue responded to a subject stuck under a tree call out of their area. BCAS made vocal contact with subject and subject refused care. SAR was stood down.

On 27 Jul 16, Campbell River SAR responded to assist and rescue a horse stuck in the mud off of McIvor Lake Road, near Campbell River.

On 28 Jul 16, BCAS requested Shuswap SAR respond for an injured rafter that needed a basket stretcher to carry the subject out. SAR was stood down as subject was transported up the embankment.

On 30 Jul 16, ESS - Quadra Island volunteers delivered food to fire rescue personnel on scene at a fire on the north end of Quadra Island.
