WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 13-19 JUN 2016

BODY RECOVERY

On 14 Jun 16, the Alberni Valley Rescue Squad responded to assist RCMP with a body recovery in Sproat River.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 14 Jun 16, Salmon Arm Rescue Society was requested by BCAS to respond to the high school with their extrication equipment when a student's hand was caught in a piece of equipment in the shop class. The student was freed and was then transported by Air Ambulance to hospital.

On 16 Jun 16, 100 Mile House Highway Rescue were called out by BCAS to provide extrication of a deceased occupant from an aircraft that crash landed in the area of Green Lake Road North.

FLOODING

On 15 Jun 16, the District of Chetwynd activated their EOC to Level 1 following a heavy rain event that resulted in flooding of the Pine River and blocked culverts which impacted the entire community of Chetwynd.

On 15 Jun 16, the NEA PREOC activated in support of several local authorities flood response following a heavy rain event.

On 15 Jun 16, The PRRD reported that severe rainfall had resulted in several water bodies to overflow and the Moberly Lake bridge collapsed cutting off 40 properties.

On 15 Jun 16, the the Peace River Regional District (PRRD) activated their EOC following an excessive rainfall event that resulted in significant flooding.

On 15 June 16, an incident was opened for the Saulteau First Nation near Chetwynd as a result of flooding from a heavy rainfall event, that impacted their community.

On 15 June 16, an incident and task number was issued for Indigenous Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) NEA region to track costs associated with flood response for several First Nations communities affected by the heavy rainfall event.

On 15 June 16, heavy rainfall in Dawson Creek washed out a culvert and caused flooding in the city. Dawson Creek activated their EOC to manage the flood response.

On 15 June 16, an incident was opened for the PRRD in response to flooding that affected areas West of Chetwynd in Dokie, Hasler Flats, Willow Flats and Wildmare.

On 15 June 16, an incident was opened for the PRRD due to flooding in the Tupper and Toms Lake areas.

On 15 June 16, the community of Pouce Coupe activated their EOC in response to flooding from a heavy rainfall event that resulted in the evacuation of the Pouce Coupe Park and Campground.

On 16 Jun 16, an incident and task number was issued for the Central Kootenay Regional District, Area D, E and F. An overflight was required to assess the area of Gar Creek and Johnson's Landing for landslide risk.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 17 June 16, the Central Okanagan Regional District activated the EOC in Kelowna in regards to the Scott Crescent Interface Fire (K50109) which was actioned by local fire resources with assistance from BC Wildfire Service. Due to the close proximity of the fire to residences, 5 homes were evacuated.

STORM EVENT

On 15 June 16, North Shore Emergency Management activated their EOC in response to a severe storm event that resulted in heavy rain and lightning that caused structure fires, power outages and localized flooding in West Vancouver.
