WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 07-13 MARCH 2016

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 10 Mar 16, a semi-truck struck a tree resulting in a spill of 200 litres of diesel to from the saddle tanks in the District of Saanich. The fuel entered the storm drains leading to Cecelia Creek. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the environmental impacts and the potential for heightened media attention.

FLOOD

On 09 Mar 16, Nanaimo EPC assisted FLNRO in regards to the removal of logs in Chase River to prevent flooding.

On 09 Mar 16, Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) opened an EOC in response to imminent flooding of the Puntledge and Tsolum Rivers.

On 10 Mar 16, the Corporation of Delta opened up their EOC in response to localized flooding in the Boundary Bay and Ladner areas.

On 11 Mar 16, Courtenay responded to flooding and erosion of several properties (4) on Douglas Place along the Puntledge River.

On 13 Mar 16, the City of Surrey opened an EOC in response to a storm surge threatening 50 homes on Crescent Beach.

SEVERE STORM

On 10 Mar 16, Abbotsford opened their EOC following a severe storm that resulted in road closures, power outages, downed trees and downed power lines.

On 10 Mar 16, Mission opened their EOC in support of implications from overnight storm event including power outages, downed trees, road closures and downed power lines.

On 10 Mar 16, SWE PREOC was activated in support of local authorities responding to issues resulting from a severe storm event.

On 10 Mar 16, Maple Ridge opened their EOC following a severe storm that resulted in power outages and downed trees.

On 10 Mar 16, Port Coquitlam was issued a task number following a severe storm/wind event.
