WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Nov 14 - 20

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 15 Nov 16, a tanker truck containing explosive materials rolled over near Powder King Ski Resort. The spilled cargo mixed with diesel fuel leaking from the truck, which resulted in the Ministry of Environment Response Officer upgrading the event to a Code 2 spill (urgent nature) due to a safety risk and a highway closure.

On 16 Nov 16, a pipe ruptured at a chemical facility in North Vancouver resulting in the release of chlorine. The chlorine distribution system was immediately shut down and the spilled material was quickly contained. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) coded the incident as a Code 2 (urgent nature), as two employees were impacted by the chemical release, taken to hospital and subsequently released.

EVIDENCE SEARCH
