DANGEROUS GOODS

On 26 Nov 16, a bulk log carrier moored in Chemainus at Catalyst Paper suffered a hydraulic line failure. This resulted in hydraulic fluid spilling to the marine. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to potential for heightened media attention.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 25 Nov 16, two roads were been washed out in Halfmoon Bay (Electoral Area B): Leaning Tree Road and Belair Road by a surge of water from a suspected beaver dam that let go. Approximately 20 families were impacted, and left with no access or egress.
