**DANGEROUS GOODS**

On 29 Nov 16, it was reported that hundreds of crabs were found dead in the Crescent Beach area of White Rock. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status), due to potential environmental impacts and heightened media attention.
