DANGEROUS GOODS (CODE 2)

On 24 April 16, a condensate fire occurred at a gas plant in a remote location outside of Fort Nelson. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) requested that the incident be raised to Code 2 (urgent status) for notification purposes.

BODY RECOVERY

On 20 April 16, North Shore Rescue recovered the body of a teen who had fallen into the river at Lynn Canyon on 01 April.

URBAN INTERFACE FIRES:

On 18 April 16, the Bulkley Nechako Regional District activated their EOC to monitor multiple local forest fires in the nearby area.

On 18 April 16, the Peace River Regional District activated their EOC to monitor multiple local forest fires in the nearby area. Several Oil and Gas plants shut in operations at a number of facilities due to the fire activity in the area.

On 18 April 16, Taylor Fire Department called to advise that they were evacuating people because of structures being threatened by an interface fire.

On 18 April 16, the Hudson's Hope EOC was activated in response to an interface fire nearby resulting in several evacuations.

On 18 April 16, the NWE Regional HQ Task was generated due to the PREOC's activation to deal with the consequences of interface fires in the region.

On 18 April 16, the NEA Regional HQ Task was generated due to the PREOC's activation to deal with consequences of interface fires in the region.

On 18 April 16, the NEA Fire Season INAC Task number was generated to track associated response costs of interface fires impacting First Nations lands.

On 18 April 16, Blueberry River First Nation evacuated the land in the area of Mile 73 of the Alaska Highway due to an interface fire in the area.

On 19 April 16, the Peace River Regional District's EPC advised there were 17 homes under evacuation for South Taylor with extensions into Electoral Area D due to interface fires.

On 19 April 16, the Peace River Regional District issued an Evacuation Alert and subsequently an Evacuation Order for a fire in the Charlie Lake area. 17 homes were affected by the Evacuation Order and 200 plus homes were affected by the Evacuation Alert.

On 19 April 16, the PECC was issued a seasonal interface fire Task number in support of activated PREOCs responding to the consequences of interface fires throughout BC.

On 20 April, an incident was opened in the Peace River Regional District when an Evacuation Alert was issued for 30 homes threatened by an interface fire in the Beatton Airport Area.
