DANGEROUS GOODS (CODE 2)

On 24 Mar 16, an incident involving run-off water at the Gibraltar Mine in Williams Lake was upgraded to Code 2 (Urgent Status). After confirming the incident involved run-off water and not tailings, the incident was downgraded to Code 1.

On 24 Mar 16, Washington State Department of Ecology advised of a large amount of manure that had spilled at a dairy farm and may have entered the Sumas River which enters Canada. This incident was made Code 2 due to the potential of it being trans-boundary incident with an immediate down grade to Code 1 once all required parties had been advised.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 22 Mar 16, the Cranbrook ESS was called out to a condo complex by the Fire Department. Two units were evacuated due to water pipes breaking in the condos. A task number was issued for WCB coverage only of ESS volunteer.

On 24 Mar 16 Princeton SAR responded to Princeton Fire Department request to rescue a dog who has fallen into the ice behind a residence in Princeton.

On 24 Mar 16, Terry Martin A/EPC for the Kootenay Boundary Regional District (KBRD) opened an incident to provide assistance to a home owner that was forced to evacuate their home due to bank instability threatening their safety.
