WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Aug 14 – 20, 2017

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 19 Aug 2017, a flash fire broke at the FortisBC Liquefied Natural Gas plant, in Delta. Product released during the incident was a mix of Propane, Butane, Ethane and Methane. 20 workers were evacuated from the area and a temporary road closure was established. The fire was immediately extinguished and the valve was shut and residual product was vented off. Police, Fire and the Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) attended and the incident was categorized as a Code 2 with immediate downgrade, for notification purposes only.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On Aug 18, 2017 Castlegar SAR responded to search the Robson area for evidence of human remains along the riverbank.

INTERFACE FIRE

On Aug 14, 2017, an incident was opened for the North Okanagan Regional District to allow for advanced planning and EOC activation due to a bordering fire that was in the township of Spallumcheen.

On 18 August an incident was created for the Tatla Lake area of the Cariboo Regional District due to a wildfire (C50934).

On 18 August 2017, an incident was created for a fire (C50744) and subsequent evacuation in the Kleena Kleene area of the Cariboo Regional District.
