WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT Aug 28 -Sept 03, 2017

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 30 Aug 2017, a fishing boat (Sea Valley II) that was transiting from Alaska to Bellingham, USA had an engine room fire off Thrasher Island, near Nanaimo. The boat started to sink and leak fuel. The incident was raised to Code 2 (urgent status), by the Ministry of Environment Response Officer, for notification purposes.

EVIDENCE SEARCH

On 29 Aug 2017, one member of the North peace SAR responded to assist the RCMP with an evidence search.

INTERFACE FIRE

On 30 Aug 2017, an incident was opened in response to an interface fire near Lamb Creek (N11927) close to Moyie within the East Kootenay Regional District (EKRD).

On 31 Aug 2017, an incident was opened due to an interface fire near Diamond Creek (K51406) in Osoyoos, within the Okanagan-Similkameen Regional District (OSRD).

On 31 Aug 2017, an interface fire resulted in an evacuation alert for 488 residents in the Harrop Proctor (K51406) area, near Nelson, within the Central Kootenay Regional District (CKRD).

On 01 Sep 2017, an interface fire threatened the FN community of Saint Mary's Reserve (N11999), within the East Kootenay Regional District (EKRD).

On 01 Sep 2017, an incident was opened for the EKRD due to the interface fire near Saint Mary's Reserve (N11999) near Nelson.

On 03 Sep 2017, Central Okanagan Regional District (CORD) reactivated their EOC to support response resulting from the Finlay Creek Fire (K52024), near Peachland.

On 03 Sept 2017, an incident was opened for the Okanagan-Similkameen Regional District (OSRD) in response to the interface fire near Finlay Creek (K52024).

On 03 Sep 2017, an incident was opened in response to the Linklater Fire (N11844) near the Tobacco Plains FN in the East Kootenay Regional District (EKRD).

On 03 Sep 2017, Cranbrook activated their EOC in response to an interface forest fire near White River (N21628). Evacuation alerts were issued for properties in the area.

On 03 Sep 2017, the Kootenay Boundary Regional District (KBRD) activated their EOC after a tactical evacuation was conducted of residences threatened by an interface fire at Hulme Creek (N62040).
