DANGEROUS GOODS

On 01 Apr 2017, RCMP discovered an abandoned Meth Lab in Richmond on Granville Ave. RCMP have hired Tervita to dispose of the hazmat materials at the location. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status).

FLOODING

On 01 Apr 17, a task was issued to the Columbia Shuswap Regional District CSRD due flooding that impacted a residents basement from an overflowing ditch along Southwind Road in Celista.

On 01 Apr 17, a task number was issued to Clearwater due flood waters across Candle Creek Road in Clearwater, that impacted the Raft River Elementary School.

On 02 Apr 17, flooding from an undersized ditch compromised a resident's septic field along Wilho Road in Sorrento, CSRD.

On 02 Apr 17, an incident was initiated due to the threat of flooding on a property at Celista, in the CSRD.

LANDSLIDE

On 01 Apr 17, a landslide incident was reported potentially impacting 2 properties on West Lake Road in Christina Lake, within Kootenay Boundary Regional District.

On 01 Apr 17, a task was issued to the Central Okanagan Regional District due to a landslide that impacted one property on Westside Drive North in West Kelowna.

On 02 Apr 17, a task number was issued to the Central Kootenay Regional District due to landslide that occurred at Taghum and Boylen Road that exposed a water main.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 01 Apr 17, Squamish SAR responded to Furry Creek FSR to assist a hiker with a large dog that had fallen and suffered an injury.
