FLOODING

On 26 April 2017, an incident was opened for flooding and bank instability on Cosens Bay Road in the North Okanagan Regional District. T

On 26 April 2017, an incident was opened due to ground instability on Greenhow Road in the North Okanagan Regional District.

On 26 April 2017, a task was opened for the NEA PREOC in support of the local authorities throughout the region that were engaged in freshet flood response activities.

On 27 April 2017, an incident was opened due to a washout of Eagle Bay Road in Columbia Shuswap Regional District, leaving potentially 318 seasonal homes stranded.

DEBRIS FLOW

On 25 April 2017, an incident was opened in response to a debris flow from residential properties into Kalamalka Lake in Vernon.

LANDSLIDE

On 26 April 2017 an incident was opened in the Cariboo Regional District to investigate a potential landslide in a rural area near the Quesnel River.

On 27 April, 2017 an incident was opened due to a landslide on Ramage Road potentially affecting six homes in Kamloops.

On 28 April 2017, an incident was opened due to a landslide on Gold Creek FSR near Kamloops.

On 28 April 2017, an incident was opened due to a landslide on McRobbie Road in the Central Okanagan Regional District.

On 28 April 2017, an incident was opened due to a landslide in Isadore Canyon in the East Kootenay Regional District, possibly affecting the City of Cranbrook sewer main line.

On 28 April 2017, an incident was opened due to a landslide below several homes near Wycliffe Park Road in the East Kootenay Regional District.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 24 April 2017, BCAS requested assistance from Quadra Island Fire Department for a cardiac patient. 8 members attended and transferred the patient to BCAS.

TRAIN COLLISION

On 30 April 2017, a head on collision between two trains on the CN line occurred in the Lone Butte area, at the end of Taylor Lake Road. 100 Mile Rescue and South Cariboo SAR responded however, CN reported that there were no injuries to its crew members. One rail-car derailed but cargo was lumber with no hazardous materials issues.
