WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 03 – 09 April 17

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 04 Apr 17, the RCMP reported a meth lab being removed from a rental property in Vernon. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer raised the event to a Code 2 (urgent status) due to the risk associated with the potentially volatile substances being removed.

On 07 Apr 17, a tanker truck loaded with 49,000 litres of diesel rolled over in a ditch alongside Highway 43, just south of Elkford. One tanker was reportedly leaking and approximately 5000 to 6000 litres of diesel was spilled to a nearby ditch. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer upgraded the incident to Code 2 (urgent status), due to potential environmental impact. The MOE RO attended the site and confirmed that the spill had been contained to the ditch. A contractor was brought in to pump out (transfer) the remaining product from the truck and the ditch.

FLOODING

On 03 Apr 17, a task was opened for the CTL PREOC in support of the local authorities throughout the region that were engaged in freshet flood response activities.

On 03 Apr 17, a task was issued to the East Kootenay Regional District due to reports of several properties near Highway 95A and Wycliffe Store Road that were experiencing overland flooding.

On 03 Apr 17, a task was issued to the Central Kootenay Regional District when Duck Creek broke its banks and threatened to flood a property on Ducklake Road.

On 03 Apr 17, a task was opened for the SEA PREOC in support of the local authorities throughout the region that were engaged in flood response activities.

On 06 Apr 17, a task was issued to Cranbrook when water levels from Elizabeth Lake were blocked by a culvert resulting in flooding at a nearby motel on Van Horne Street.

ICE JAM

On 03 Apr 17, a task was issued to the Fraser Fort George Regional District due to the potential for flooding resulting from large ice pans on the Salmon River. The concern was that the ice would restrict flow of the river causing flood concern for one residence and a commercial campground area upstream however no further concern arose and the incident was closed.

LANDSLIDE

On 07 Apr 17, a landslide in the Father Lake Hill area compromised a road leading to several residents in the District of Spallumcheen.

On 07 Apr 17, a mudslide destroyed two homes on Sunnybrae Canoe Point Road east of Tappen. 4 homes were evacuated and one family of 5 were provided Emergency Social Services.

POWER OUTAGE

On 06 Apr 17, a task was issued for North Vancouver to activate their EOC when a BC Hydro substation 12kV switch was affected by water during routine roof maintenance that resulted in a power outage affecting approximately 12,000 residents in the North Shore area of North Vancouver.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 05 Apr 17, Nanaimo SAR responded to conduct a rope rescue of a dog that became stranded over 15' an embankment in the Lantzville foothills area.

On 07 Apr 17, ESS was provided to 4 people who were displaced from their home in Vancouver when a building under construction collapsed during a windstorm and impacted their residence.
