DANGEROUS GOODS

On 6 Jan 17, a motor vehicle incident on Highway 1, near Sicamous, resulted in the road being closed, when fuel was spilled on the roadway and a person was trapped inside one of the vehicles. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 due to public safety issues.

On 8 Jan 17, a motor vehicle incident on Highway 97C near Pennask closed the road for a transport truck moving hazardous materials was blown off the road and was possibly leaking materials. The MOE RO raised the incident to Code 2 due to public safety concerns.

FLOODING

On 06 Jan 17, one residence was flooded on Creighton Valley Road in Lumby. The North Okanagan Regional District activated their EOC in order to have someone attend the site.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 05 Jan 17, 24 people were evacuated from their apartment building as a result of a natural gas leak in Pitt Meadows. A reception center was set up for the people by local ESS.
