WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 09 – 15 Jan 2017

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 12 Jan 17, 29 rail cars carrying metallurgical coal derailed near Ashcroft. Four of these cars tipped onto their side and slid down an embankment. None of the cars entered the water however, an estimated 160 tons of coal entered the Thompson River. The Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to Code 2 (urgent status) due to the potential for environmental and public safety concerns. CP Rail emergency crews responded and worked to repair the track, undertake cleanup operations and arrange for water samples to be taken for analysis. MOE downgraded the incident after initial water quality analysis indicated no drinking water issues.

FLOODING

On 14 Jan 17, a task number was issued to cover the provision of sand for sandbagging and volunteers to assist residents threatened by flooding from the Goat River in Creston.

MISCELLANEOUS

On 12 Jan 17, a task number was provided to Vancouver ESS for several warming centers that were opened during a period of extremely cold weather back on the 5 Jan 2017.
