WEEKLY INCIDENT REPORT 20 to 26 March

DANGEROUS GOODS

On 24 March 2017, a spill was reported of sheen from derelict vessels in the Stave River. A Ministry of Environment Response Officer (MOE RO) raised the incident to a Code 2 (urgent status) when the sheen was determined to be a significant size and from 136-foot sunken vessel.

ENVIRONMENTAL

On 20 March 2017, a landslide occurred on the Deer Park Forest Service Road causing the road to slide into the lake. Deer Park FSR is the access road for 12 year-round residents.

On 20 March 2017, Emergency Social Services were provided for the occupants of three homes on Reclamation Road in West Creston who had been evacuated from their homes since the weekend due to flooding.

On 23 March 2017, a Provincial Regional Emergency Operations Centre was opened in the Southeast region in support of several mudslides and floods in the region.

On 23 March, 2017, a task number was issued in response to flooding on Loon Lake Road in the Central Kootenay Regional District.
