

INITIAL DETECTION - ID

Initial Detection refers to the means by which the fire incident was first detected.

If the method of initial detection is known but is not included in the classifications listed below, code under 0009.

- 1000 Smoke alarm device
- 2000 Smoke detector device
- 3000 Heat alarm device
- 4000 Heat detector device
- 5000 Automatic sprinkler system
- 6000 Automatic system other than sprinkler
- 7000 Visual sighting or other means of personal detection (e.g. smell)
- 8000 No initial detection (extinguished before detection)
- 9000 Specialty detector (includes flame, beam, line)

- 0008 Not applicable – (e.g. vehicle, outdoor, person)
- 0009 Initial detection - unclassified (describe)
- 0000 Cannot be determined
