The Spring 2017 LEH Draw is Now Open for Applications

You can apply online at www.gov.bc.ca/hunting, or visit a Service BC, FrontCounter BC, or participating vendor location.

Thanks to hunter feedback, we have improved the Group hunt LEH application process. The new process will make it easier for hunters to create or join a Group hunt. If you are planning to apply as a group, [review the updated instructions](#).

The application deadline is Friday February 10, 2017. Applications for the spring draw are for Grizzly Bear and Skeena Region mountain sheep Limited Entry Hunts only. More information on applying for the fall LEH draw will be in the [2017-2018 LEH Regulations Synopsis](#), available online in the spring of 2017.

Hunting Licences are not yet available using the new BC Hunting online service. Hunting licences are available at [Service BC](#) and local participating hunting and sporting goods stores.

Hunting provides British Columbians an opportunity to get out into British Columbia's world-renowned backcountry and enjoy the natural wonders of our province.

Resident hunters should be familiar with B.C. hunting laws and regulations.

As of April 2016, B.C. resident hunters now need a Fish & Wildlife ID (FWID) to apply for Limited Entry Hunting or to buy a hunting licence.

The FWID replaces the old B.C. resident Hunter Number card. There is no cost to obtain one. Your FWID is linked to your personal online profile, which can be updated at any time. If you have forgotten your Hunter Number or FWID, contact a [FrontCounter BC](#) agent for assistance.




Step 2 – Logon to BCellD

Step 3 – View your LEH application history


You can view your LEH Application details on the Fish and Wildlife Profile screen by clicking **View LEH History** then clicking the link below the **Application Type** heading.
