EXECUTIVE COUNCIL CHAMBERS, VICTORIA MAY. 1

Pursuant to the Mineral Act and Placer-mining Act, and upon the recommendation of the undersigned, the Lieutenant-Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, orders that

No person shall locate upon any of the lands within the following described area in the Victoria Mining Division, Renfrew Land District:

Area "A": Commencing at a point 7 chains due east and 26 chains due north of the northwest corner of Lot 570; thence due east 7 chains; thence due south 8 chains; thence due west 7 chains more or less to a point due south of the aforesaid point of commencement; thence north 8 chains more or less to said point of commencement.

Area "B": Commencing at a point 21.5 chains due east and 21 chains due north of the northwest corner of Lot 570; thence due east 10 chains; thence due south 13 chains; thence due west 10 chains more or less to a point due south of the aforesaid point of commencement; thence north 13 chains more or less to said point of commencement.

Area "C": Commencing at a point 7 chains due north of the northeast corner of Lot 570; thence due west 6 chains; thence due south 7 chains; thence due east 6 chains more or less to a point due south of the aforesaid point of commencement; thence north 7 chains more or less to said point of commencement.

(2) Upon the expiry of the term or cancellation of any existing mineral claim, placer claim or lease, or lease issued under the Mineral Act or upon the reversion to the Crown in the right of the Province of any Crown⊷granted mineral claim the lands formerly contained in these instruments which fall within the above area shall immediately upon such expiry or cancellation or reversion become subject to this order and no person shall locate upon such lands.
