Multi-Day Ticket Raffle Events Sample Ticket – Custom Printed Tickets

BEFORE YOU START

Custom printed tickets are required where any ticket sales period exceeds one day.

Class A applicants projecting \$100,000 or more in gross sales must submit a sample ticket for review as part of their application. Reviews of all other sample tickets are completed at the request of the applicant.

It is recommended applicants review all relevant rules and requirements related to ticket raffle requirements for a licensed gaming event, refer to the <u>Licensed Charitable Gaming Rules</u>:

- Section 11.8 Raffle Ticket Requirements for Single Day Events
- Section 11.9 Raffle Ticket Requirements for Multi-Day Events
- Section 11.10 Multi-Series Tickets
- Section 11.11 Discounted Tickets

Please note, for Electronic Raffle System (ERS) licensees, ticket raffle requirements differ as per Section 12.
